Save time, fuel and money with Sound Transit's Link light rail! Link travels between University of Washington Station and Angle Lake Station, making 14 stops along the way, including downtown Seattle and Sea-Tac Airport. Adult fares range from \$2.25 to \$3.25; Children 5 & under ride free; Youth 6-18 pay \$1.50; Seniors 65+ & Disabled pay \$1.00. ## PURCHASE YOUR TICKET BEFORE BOARDING

Ticket kiosks are touch screens with easy-to-follow directions. After you select your destination, you'll be asked to deposit your fare. Payment can be made by cash or credit card, and multiple tickets can be purchased in one transaction for group travel. An "all day pass" is available (purchased as a "round trip" fare) specifically for the light rail.

## LIGHT RAIL TIPS & INFO

### TRAVEL TIMES:

- Airport to Westlake Station: 38 minutes
- Airport to University Street Station: 36 minutes
- Airport to University of Washington Station: 44 minutes
- Airport to Angle Lake Station: 4 minutes

### HOURS OF SERVICE:

Service is available from 5 a.m. to 1 a.m. Monday through Saturday and from 6 a.m. to midnight on Sunday and holidays.

Northbound (Airport to Westlake Station)

- Monday thru Saturday: 5:04 a.m. - 12:10 a.m.
- Sunday: 6:19 a.m. - 11:05 p.m.

Southbound (Westlake Station to Airport)

- Monday thru Saturday: 5:05 a.m. - 12:37 a.m.
- Sunday: 6:20 a.m. - 11:37 p.m.

### TRAIN FREQUENCY:

Trains run every 6, 10 or 15 minutes depending on the time of day. For a complete schedule, visit [soundtransit.org](http://soundtransit.org).

### WHICH STATION TO USE:

- Use Westlake Station for the Washington State Convention Center and hotels north of University Street.
- Use University Street Station for hotels on or south of University Street.
- Other downtown Seattle stations include Pioneer Square, International District/Chinatown and Stadium.
- Use Angle Lake Station for hotels south of the Airport.

Please note: Light rail information subject to change.
